STPP Letter of Access (LoA) Purchase for 2010 Registration

As we already communicated to you on 4th March 2010, the STPP REACH Joint Registration Dossier was completed, submitted and has been formally accepted by ECHA in February 2010.

The principle of financial conditions explained in our email of 19th October 2009 has been agreed by a number of SIEF members who have signed the relevant documents and made the specified payments, and no objection has been received by any other SIEF Member.

Consequently, the price for 2010 (>1,000 tonnes) Registration Letter of Access is now fixed as a function of the number of companies which committed and paid before the announced deadline of 30th November 2009, corresponding to the early preparation and submission of this dossier.

The total cost of the dossier preparation (see notes below), has been maintained within the budget initially announced in our email of 19th October 2009 (482 860 Euros ex VAT) and the cost of LoA is thus:

- **68 020 Euros ex-VAT for LoA for > 1,000 tonnes Registration**

How to obtain LoA: LOAShop online procedure

The following steps are obligatory and necessary conditions for obtaining 2010 LoA (*except for those companies having already signed the STPP commitment form and made payments, for whom this procedure is not applicable*)

- **Online procedure using ReachCentrum online LOAShop**

 - **online signature of the SIEF Agreement Contract**
(no online signature, no possibility to purchase LoA)
 - **submit details of your affiliates, represented parties for ORs**
 - **commit to purchase LoA, and request invoice**
- **Payment of invoice** for the LoA cost indicated above.
 - **on receipt and registration by the Consortium of full payment, you will receive the Registration Token and an electronic (PDF) Letter of Access**

The online signature and payment system is online as of today and each of these steps can be done as of now.

It is in your interest to sign up to the SIEF Agreement Contract as rapidly as possible:

- Online signature of STPP SIEF Agreement Contract is obligatory to obtain LoA
- Risks of missing Registration deadline if you delay, given the time necessary to receive, pay and register your LoA invoice, submit your own company dossier, pay ECHA Fees and receive your Registration Number, particularly in the case of incidents or saturation with the ReachCentrum

LOAShop or with the ECHA website, or incidents with payment references or transfers, or any other non foreseeable incident. The STPP Consortium takes no responsibility for consequences in such cases.

- On signature, we will send to you documentation to facilitate Registration preparation: "Registration Notes" concerning organisation of dossier preparation for different sections of IUCLID, spectra and analysis recommendations for inorganic phosphates, model spectra waiver texts, etc
- Through LOAShop, you can communicate information concerning affiliates, companies for which you are acting as Only Representative. This information is obligatory for obtaining Letter of Access
- As soon as you have completed this information, you will be able to commit online to purchase LoA
- After you have completed the online procedure, and as soon as your full payment has been received and registered you will receive the Token (and so be able to submit your company's own Registration mini-dossier)

Important notes concerning LoA cost

- Calculation is according to the STPP Consortium Agreement (see online on Consortium website) financial conditions, and includes the Advantage Compensation Payment
- Amount will be lower for post-2010 tonnage bands : see figures indicated in our email of 4th March 2010 on Consortium website
- The Access Rights are accorded for use for REACH Registration of the single substance STPP only, and for use for no other purposes and for no other substances.
- If you are acting as an Only Representative for two (or more) different companies, then the above cost must be paid two (or more) times.
- The above figures do not include ECHA registration fees, nor LOAShop handling fee (425 Euros)
- This cost does NOT include: the possible cost of taking into account any further information which may be communicated to us in the future, nor any modifications of the dossier which could result from such information, nor any administrative costs of updating the dossier if this becomes necessary in the future. It does not include the costs of carrying out the study submitted as Testing Proposal, nor of any other additional testing ECHA may require after examination of the dossier. All such additional costs must be shared between all registrants (where concerned according to tonnage bands), and will be additional to those indicated here.
- Conform to the conditions indicated in our email of 19th October 2010, and subject to the above, this is now a fixed dossier access cost, and no partial refund will now be given if further companies purchase access to the dossier.
